# CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

May 8, 2025

The Capital Campaign Drive Repository will formally stop accepting donations on May 15, 2025.

A new repository, the **Building Fund**, has been created to take its place and will start accepting donations on May 15, 2025.

Members and Friends may make contributions designated for capital expenses, including the purpose of obtaining property to the **Building Fund** at any time.

As established at the beginning of the Capital Campaign on March 31, 2023, donors, who so designated at the time of their donation, have the option to receive, upon request, a refund of their Capital Campaign donations should a home (or equivalent or via a partnership) not be purchased within 4 years of the beginning of the Capital Campaign or on March 31, 2027.

Please ensure that any donations for our future home are designated for the "Building Fund."


