# Lesbian Visibility Day is April 26:

Recognized since 2008 as a way of acknowledging the perceived erasure of lesbian spaces and the need to preserve and celebrate lesbian culture, distinct as it is from other gay, bi, trans, and queer experiences.

This day celebrates lesbians and shows solidarity with all LGBTQI women and non-binary people in our community. We believe in unity and lifting those who are most marginalized. It is essential that Lesbian Visibility Day is a voice for unity and lifts up ALL women, especially those who come from marginalized communities," the site continues. "Recent research (Pride Matters survey, conducted by Pride In London 2018) has shown that gay women are almost twice as unlikely to be out in the workplace as gay male colleagues."

It is meant as a time for lesbians to be seen, heard, and celebrated. Just like any other week to commemorate different groups in the LGBTQ+ community, Lesbian Visibility Week is a great time to reflect on how lesbians are treated within the LGBTQ+ community and in everyday life.

This short book shows how gallows humor can bolster us to confront global warming. We've all seen the headlines: oceans rising, historic heat waves, mass extinctions, climate refugees. It feels overwhelming. Stay Cool tells us to laugh our way forward. Human beings have used comedy to cope with difficult realities since the beginning of recorded time—the more dismal the news, the darker the humor. Using this rich tradition of dark comedy to investigate climate change, Aaron Sachs makes the case that gallows humor can cultivate endurance, persistence, and solidarity in the face of calamity.
