Loosen, Baby: Flowers for Ferdinand ... and You Annual Flower Ceremony

All the other little bulls would run and jump and butt their heads together, but not Ferdinand. He like to sit just quietly and smell the flowers. One hundred and one years ago in June 1923, amidst a world of despair and destruction, the Rev Norbert Çapek held the first Flower Ceremony with his congregation in Prague, Czechoslovakia to celebrate beauty and joy in the power of loving community.

Over eighty years ago, with World War 2 brewing, the author Munro Leaf gave us the story of Ferdinand, a peace-loving little bull who didn't want to fight, but smell the flowers.

How might these two threads be woven together in our own time?

This Sunday we, too, gather in beauty, love, and delight with our own annual Flower Ceremony — while we welcome new members and carry on our traditions of hope and resilience in our own troubled world.


BUUkies will discuss "Home Front" on Wednesday, Jun 19th at 7:00 pm.
